### Mr. Elie CAVIGNEAUX

Mr. Cavigneaux holds a Master's degree from Sorbonne University, France. In 2004 Mr. Cavigneaux began working at the Middle East and North Africa Department of the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs. From 2007 to 2009 Mr. Cavigneaux was in charge of the European Neighbourhood Policy, participating in negotiations on new agreements and action plans (between EU and third countries of the South Mediterranean) and contributing to a sector policy dialogue with the ENP partners. From 2009 Mr. Cavigneaux assumed the role of Political Advisor at the French Embassy in Poland. In 2013 he took over the position of Advisor on European issues at the French Embassy in Germany.

### Contribution

Mr. Elie Cavigneaux, Advisor to the EU Counter-Terrorism Coordinator, Council of the European Union, emphasized that cooperation between EU and Jordan can assist in overcoming the issue of radicalization in various societies. He clarified the means in which the EU is able to support the action of his member states in a comprehensive anti-radicalization effort with particular emphasis on prison rehabilitation programs and the growth of an effective communication strategy.
